- Maintains confidential records as required by federal, state, and local mandates
- Collaborates with Teacher II in a manner that will promote a team teaching approach
- Integrates classroom and home activities and experiences from parents for the growth and development of children
- Ensures parents are welcomed as classroom volunteers and develops a volunteer activity plans, provides classroom volunteer training, and maintains volunteer records
- Maintains professional competency by participating in career development activities such as field related up-to-date continued training/education and personal growth experiences
- Performs such other duties as incumbent upon the position and as assigned
